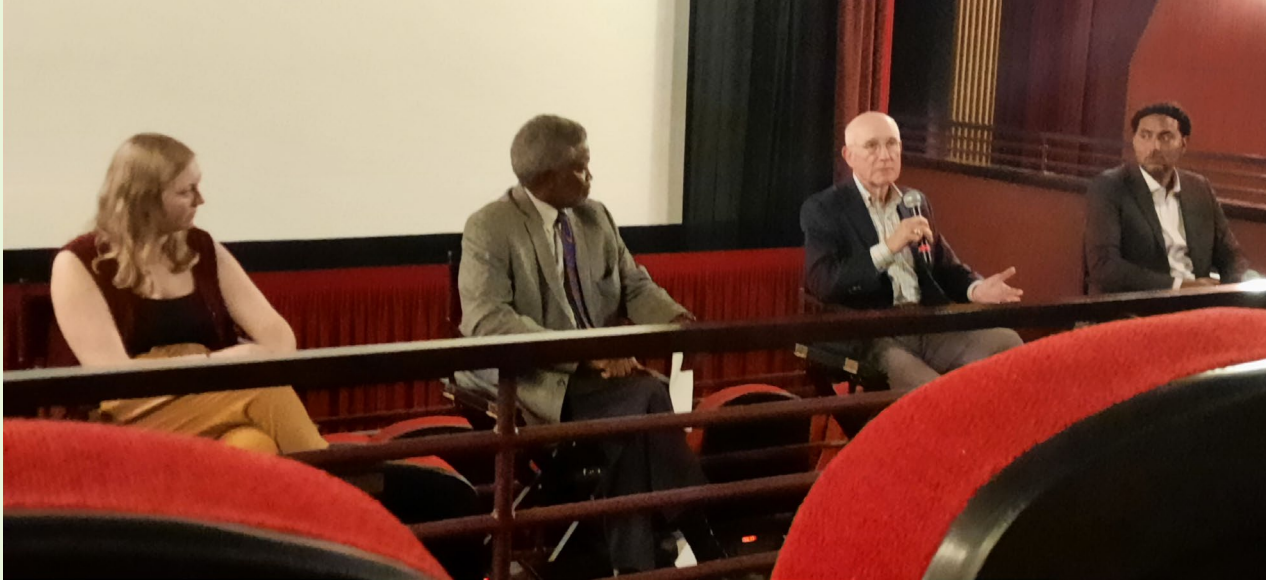




“Meltdown in Dixie” at the Nickelodeon Theater

Event: July 13, 2022: SCHAC CRD attended the “Meltdown in Dixie” screening at the Nickelodeon Theater in Columbia, SC. Following the screening, there was a panel featuring Filmmaker Emily Harrold, Judge Gary Clary, Representative Justin Bamberg, and moderated by Dr. Larry Watson.

The panel answered questions centered around their experiences in the SC State House when the flag was removed from the State House grounds in 2015.
