

South Carolina Emergency Management Division Training

Event: On October 11th, 2021, Bethany Morton from the South Carolina Emergency Management Division (SCEMD) conducted a training about emergency management services across the state of South Carolina.

Background: The South Carolina Emergency Management Division leads the state emergency management program by supporting local authorities to minimize the loss of life and property from all-hazard events. South Carolina is divided into six regions with a manager and a coordinator in each region. SCEMD is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to provide support for crisis situations (flood, fire, hurricanes, etc.). SCEMD helps coordinate response and recovery efforts as well as train, assist, and assess Emergency Management plans throughout the state. SCHAC will collaborate with SCEMD regarding Community Relations matters.
